SUBJECT: Application Fees

Fees charged by HLPC vary around the state. Some do not charge a fee, and some run in excess of \$225 per application. I would recommend a fee of \$125 for Randolph County. This fee would cover cost of legal advertising and standard signage. Signage approved by the Commission in excess of the standard sign will be charged to the applicant.

Fees would be waived for landmark designations requested by the Commission or local governments, however, cost of signage in excess of standard shall be the responsibility of the local government.

If an application is denied by the Commission, \$75 would be returned to the applicant.
