NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING

Monday, February 11, 2019

6:00 p.m.

The Randolph County Board of Commissioners has called a special meeting for Monday, February 11, 2019, at 6:00 p.m., in the Historic Courthouse Meeting Room, 145 Worth Street, Asheboro, NC, to conduct a public hearing to consider comments of citizens of Randolph County related to proposed revisions to the franchise issued to Waste Management of the Carolinas, Inc. ("Waste Management") on April 7, 2014, for disposal of municipal solid waste in the Great Oak Landfill and to consider certain associated changes to the agreement with Waste Management for the operation of said landfill. The Great Oak Landfill is bordered by Henley Country Road, Old Cedar Falls Road, Deep River, and the Old Randolph County Landfill.

The proposed revisions are generally summarized as clarifying the property covered by the franchise; increasing the allowed average daily intake from 2,000 tons per day to 4,000 tons per day; changing the franchise term to "life of site" to comply with current law; and to clarify and affirm limits on posted gate rates. Other essential terms of the franchise remain unchanged.

A copy of the franchise is located in the Asheboro Public Library at 201 Worth Street in Asheboro. A copy will also be found on the county's website.

The public hearing will take place February 11, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. at the Historic County Courthouse, Second Floor, 145 Worth St., Asheboro, N.C. Any citizen who wishes to speak is invited and allowed to do so. Each speaker will be required to sign in and will be allotted five (5) minutes to address the Board of Commissioners. Furthermore, comments may be submitted in writing to the Clerk to the Board of the Randolph County Commissioners at any time before or after the public hearing but prior to March 8, 2019. Written comments should be mailed to Randolph County, Attn: Clerk to the Board, 725 McDowell Road, Asheboro, NC 27205. Voting on these matters will take place at the Randolph County Board of Commissioners' regular meetings in March and April, said meetings to be held on March 11, 2019 and April 1, 2019.
