DECLARATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

SECTION 1. DETERMINATION

Pursuant to the County of Randolph Emergency Management Ordinance, Randolph County Emergency Operating Procedures, Chapter 166A of the General Statutes and Article 36A Chapter 14 of the General Statutes, I have determined that a local State of Emergency as defined therein exists in the County of Randolph due to issues created by the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

SECTION 2. DECLARATION

I, therefore, declare the existence of a local State of Emergency in the County of Randolph in all unincorporated geographic areas.

SECTION 3. ORDER OF COOPERATION

I hereby order all county law enforcement officers and employees and all emergency management workers subject to my control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of provisions necessary to address and abate the emergency.

SECTION 4. COUNTY OPERATIONS

I hereby further order and authorize the Randolph County Manager, after consultation with the Crisis Management Team, to initiate appropriate personnel and County operational actions as may be determined necessary to ensure County Government continuity of services that may be impacted by issues created by COVID-19. These initiatives could include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Workforce assessments that encourage Telework/Computer public interactions
- Centralized points of access for public accessibility
- Work schedule modifications, including work from home
- Travel restrictions (conferences, Meetings, training, etc.)
- Volunteer restrictions/modifications
- Return to work policy/assessments for sick employees
- Workforce reductions and possible physical relocations
- Implementation of County Business Continuity Plan

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE/TIME

This declaration shall become effective immediately. Declared the 16 day of March, 2020, at 4:00 am / (pm).
