I. Call to Order

The Randolph County Board of Health held a called meeting on Tuesday, February 26, 2019, in Randolph County Health Department conference room. Dr. Lee, Board Chair, called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m.

II. Public Comment Period

Dr. Lee opened the public comment period. Hearing no requests, the public comment period was closed.

III. Discussion/Rule Repeal – *A Rule to Prohibit Tobacco on Local Government Grounds and in Local Government Buildings and Vehicles*

Susan Hayes, Randolph County Health Director, explained the progression of the tobacco prohibition rule with changes that have been considered and approved. Board members discussed the rule approved by the Randolph County Board of Health on January 3, 2019 (*see rule following the minutes*) in comparison to the current draft rule presented. There were varying opinions on the unincorporated regions of the county and how the rule applies to those sections. Aimee Scotton, Randolph County Staff Attorney, addressed board member concerns.


After board discussion, on a motion from Dr. Walker, seconded by Hope Haywood, the Board voted eight to one (8-1) with Marianne Evans opposing to approve the repeal of "*A Rule to Prohibit Tobacco on Local Government Grounds and in Local Government Buildings and Vehicles.*" The motion passed with a majority vote.

IV. Presentation of Draft Proposal - *A Rule to Prohibit the Use of Tobacco and Tobacco Products on Randolph County Government Grounds and in Randolph County Buildings and Vehicles*

Susan Hayes, Health Director, presented a draft proposal of *A Rule to Prohibit the Use of Tobacco and Tobacco Products on Randolph County Government Grounds and in Randolph County Buildings and Vehicles (draft rule proposal following the minutes)*. Ms. Hayes noted revisions from the original rule approved on January 3, 2019. Revisions included changing the word "*Local*" to "*Randolph County Government*" to clarify that the rule applies to Randolph County owned properties. Board members reviewed and discussed the proposed draft rule.

After further discussion, on a motion from Dr. Walker, seconded by Hope Haywood, the Board voted eight to one (8-1) with Marianne Evans opposing to approve "*A Rule to Prohibit the Use of Tobacco and Tobacco Products on Randolph County Government Grounds and in Randolph County Buildings and Vehicles.*" The motion passed with a majority vote.
