



Animal Control




837 animals adopted; 2 Cases of Rabies.
 6 New Leash on Life events; 20 dogs graduated.
 94% of complaints were resolved within the first visit.
 14 animal adoption fairs were held.

Environmental Health



1,454 food and lodging inspections.
 100% food related complaints investigated within 24 hours.
 472 well permits issued.
 100% of sewage complaints resolved within 72 hours.

Clinical Services



2,309 state required childhood immunizations administered.
 646 cases of sexually transmitted infections were reported.
 1,044 clients served in family planning with 820 clients at or below 150% of poverty level.



Dental Health



6,679 students screened.
369% increase in number of students screened.
337 referrals were made.
58% increase in children referred.



3,556 participants served. **WIC**
36% of women who initiated breastfeeding continued after 6 weeks.
96% of breastfeeding mothers received appropriate support from a peer counselor.



Child Health



194 children in childcare aged 3-5 were screened in vision and hearing. A decrease of 71% in reportable communicable disease cases in school and childcare facilities.



Health Education

36 community Health Education events reaching 2,815 participants. 25 families received a child safety seat. 1,500 people were active during the Play Daze events.
