Notice of a public hearing and public comment period for the issuance of a draft Permit to Construct the proposed Great Oak Landfill, a municipal solid waste landfill facility (MSWLF) located at 3597 Old Cedar Falls Road Highway 78, Randleman, NC 27317 in Randolph County, pursuant to 15A NCAC 13B .1600 of the Solid Waste Management Rules is hereby given. The MSWLF property is owned by Randolph County and would be operated under contract and franchise by Waste Management of Carolinas, Inc.

The proposed Great Oak Landfill MSWLF facility is bordered to the north by the Deep River, to the west by the closed Randolph County landfill, to the south by Henley Country Road, and to the east by Old Cedar Falls Road. The proposed entrance would be from Old Cedar Falls Road. The entire property is 666.40 acres with a proposed disposal area of approximately 200 acres. The "Service Area" is the State of North Carolina.

There are two components of a permit for a new facility, the Permit to Construct and the Permit to Operate. This draft permit is for a 10-year Permit to Construct for Phase 1.

Phase 1 of the proposed landfill will encompass a total area of approximately 56.3 acres. Phase 1 has been sized to have a capacity life of approximately 10 years based on an average annual rate of approximately 572,000 tons per year.

A Public Hearing on the new facility plan and permit is scheduled for Thursday December 3, 2015 at 6:00 PM in the Commissioners Meeting Room, Randolph County Historic Courthouse, 145-C Worth Street, Asheboro, NC 27203. Interested parties may submit oral or written statements and data concerning the proposed new facility permit at the public hearing. Persons wishing to speak may register at the hearing and will be allotted five (5) minutes to present their comments.

All data submitted by the applicant is available as part of the administrative record and may be reviewed during business hours (9 AM - 4 PM, Monday-Friday, by appointment) at the Division of Waste Management, 217 W. Jones Street, Raleigh, NC 27603. The administrative record may be viewed online at <http://portal.ncdenr.org/web/wm/sw>. Select the "Documents" link from the list on the left side of the page. Once redirected, enter 76XX in the "ID" field and then click the "Search" button.
