

ADDENDUM “A”

Request for Proposal RFP #15-0225

Video Arraignment System

THIS ADDENDUM HEREBY CLARIFIES, MODIFIES, or RESPONDS to QUESTIONS received regarding the Randolph County **Request for Proposal #15-0225** for the Video Arraignment System issued on Wednesday, February 25, 2015. This Addendum is being issued to notify potential Vendors of changes, additions, or needed clarifications that are being made to the specifications of **RFP #15-0225**.

The following is a question that has been received by Randolph County and the County’s response:

Question: *Will any existing items/parts be reused?*

Answer: All items/parts including the datacom rack at the courthouse and the security cabinet at the jail should be quoted new.

All replaced items/parts are to be returned to Randolph County.

Question: *Should proposal include adding a UPS to the data rack in the courthouse?*

Answer: Yes

Question: *Can the County network link between the Courthouse and the Jail locations be used for sending audio and video to and from these locations?*

Answer: Yes. The current video arraignment system uses the County network link between the Courthouse and Jail locations to send audio and video to and from these locations. The new proposed system can use the County network or the dedicated fiber.

Cont'd:

Change in Quantity:

The quantity of gooseneck desktop microphones has changed from three (3) to four (4) in all courtrooms. The style breakdown is as follows per courtroom:

3) LED status, push to mute microphones with a switch on the underside of the microphone to set the default mode to either talk or mute (Judge, Prosecuting Attorney & Defense Attorney)

1) LED status, standard microphone (Witness stand)

All four microphones will tie into existing AOC recording system

No video is being recorded

Clarifications:

All data rooms in the courthouse are stacked on top of each other on each floor

Courtroom Locations:

Courtroom 1A is on the 1st floor

Courtroom 3B is on the 2nd floor

Courtroom 4A is on the 4th floor
