On March 10, 2022, the Randolph County Sheriff's Office arrived to Charles Mtn. Rd., Denton in reference to serving outstanding Orders for Arrest on Christopher Wayne Strickland. Upon arrival, Stickland was located and placed under arrest. During the arrest, heroin was located. He was transported to the Randolph County Detention Center where he was served the outstanding Orders and probable cause was found for the charge of felony possession of heroin. Strickland received a \$183,000 total secured bond and a first appearance was set for March 11, 2022, in Randolph County District Court.

On March 2, 2022, the Randolph County Sheriff's Office Vice and Narcotics Division concluded an investigation related to the distribution of Methamphetamine in the Asheboro area. Detectives, along with the assistance of the Randolph County Sheriff's Office Emergency Response Team, executed a search warrant on Oakland Ave. in Asheboro, the residence of Timothy Derrick Fore. During the search, Detectives located and

seized Methamphetamine, Hydrocodone, several firearms and items of drug paraphernalia.

Timothy Derrick Fore was charged with Felony Possess Methamphetamine, Felony Maintain Vehicle/Dwelling/Place for Controlled Substance, Misdemeanor Possession Marijuana Up to $\frac{1}{2}$ oz., Misdemeanor Simple Possession Schedule II, Misdemeanor Possession Marijuana Paraphernalia and Misdemeanor Possession Drug Paraphernalia. He was transported to Randolph County Detention Center and given a \$5,000 Secured Bond with a court date scheduled for March 7, 2022, in Randolph County District Court.

She was given a \$7,500 secured bond and is set to appear in court in Randolph County District Court on March 7, 2022.

On March 5, 2022, the Randolph County Sheriff's Office was advised to be on the lookout for a stolen vehicle from within the City of Asheboro. Deputies were advised that a firearm was present in the vehicle when it was stolen. A short time later, deputies responded to an assault call on Allred St. in Franklinville where the stolen vehicle was located. The caller reported that Wanda Sheree Carter had arrived at the residence in the stolen vehicle and subsequently assaulted the caller. During the investigation, the firearm was located and recovered. 

On March 3, 2022, the Randolph County Sheriff's Patrol Deputies, Criminal Investigations and Crime Scene Division responded with area fire departments and the Fire Marshall's Office to five separate and distinct fire locations on Cedar Grove Drive Extension in Asheboro. One fire spread to a vacant outbuilding and ignited a building. A second fire ignited three vehicles. The other three fires burned wooded areas. There were no injuries from the incident. These incidents were investigated as intentional arsons.

During the investigation, detectives were able to generate a suspect identified as Tierra Shannice Smith, who was found in the area. Following the investigation, the magistrate found probable cause for the charges of felony burning certain buildings, felony burning personal property and five counts of misdemeanor setting fire to woods against Smith.

On March 4, 2022, Detectives arrested Smith, transported her to the Randolph County Detention Center where she was served with the Warrants. She was issued a \$15,000 secured bond with the release order of being placed on Electronic House Arrest when released. A first appearance was set for March 7, 2022, in Randolph County District Court.



On March 4, 2022, the Randolph County Sheriff's Office responded to the area of Lions Rest Road and Old Cox Road, in regards to a possible overdose. Upon arrival, the female, later identified as August Rose Lockhart, was found sitting in a vehicle and advised that she had just came to the area to sit and cool off after an argument. During a subsequent search, illegal substances were located. Lockhart was arrested and transported to the Randolph County Detention Center, where the magistrate found probable cause for charges of felony possession of heroin and misdemeanor simple possession of schedule II controlled substance and issued a secured \$1,000 bond. A first appearance was set for March 7, 2022, in Randolph County District Court.

On March 4, 2022, a Randolph County Sheriff's Office Deputy initiated a traffic stop in the area of Howard Mill Rd and Bennett Rd. in Bennett. The vehicle began to speed up and a vehicle pursuit ensued. The vehicle, with two occupants, turned left onto Waddell's Ferry Rd. and continued onto the dirt/gravel portion of the road leading to a series of trails. Hussey was also served his outstanding Warrants for arrest for felony flee to elude arrest with motor vehicle, felony assault with a deadly weapon on government official, misdemeanor resisting public officer, two counts drive left of center, three counts fail to stop at stop sign, driving while licenses revoked, speeding, displaying a fictitious registration plate, and reckless driving wanton disregard; and Orders for Arrest for failure to appear. He was issued a secured \$62,500 total bond and a first appearance was set for March 7, 2022, in Randolph County District Court.

The magistrate also found probable cause for the charges of felony possession of methamphetamine and misdemeanor possession of drug paraphernalia for other than marijuana for Spivey. She received a \$5,000 unsecured bond and a court date was set for March 28, 2022.
